What is Hollybrook Schools Association?

A school association is a group of parents/carers and teachers who volunteer to raise essential funds to provide the children with equipment that is not covered by the school's budget, including playground equipment and technology within the classroom. With budgets being cut dramatically, the association is needed today more than ever before within our schools to ensure our children receive the best possible educational experience during their time at Hollybrook.

The infant school has had an active association for many years but the junior school has found it harder to find volunteers, possibly because many parents are back in full time work. With both schools now working closely together since they became part of the JET trust and with the majority of children who attend the infant school moving onto the junior school, the idea was put forward to have a joint association so that the children could benefit from funds raised from reception through to Year 6.

As a parent/carer of a child at Hollybrook you are automatically a member of Hollybrook Schools Association and your help is always welcome and needed. As a charitable association, we do have to have a formal committee but there are only a few of us and we always need help from extra volunteers so events we would like to run can happen. *Please don't be shy, we are not a closed group and really do welcome everyone.* Your input can be as much or as little as you choose to commit to, so please do look out for information on how you can get involved throughout the year. We recently sent out a survey asking whether you would like to support a schools association and we had a huge response, suggesting that evening meetings would be a popular choice. We have listened and will be organising both evening and morning meetings in the future and look forward to welcoming as many of you as possible to these.

As a joint association working with children of very different ages, we are well aware that we will still need to have separate events. All funds raised will be split fairly between the two schools, so all joint events will be divided equally and separate events organised will benefit the school involved.

We are pleased to announce that at the infant AGM in October we handed a cheque to the infant school for the fantastic amount of **£4500** raised from events during the year. A huge thank you to everyone who made this possible.
