We have made provision for children in receipt of FSM to continue receiving meals during this latest period of closure. Due to the fast pace at which the situation has changed, the provision is slightly different for the remainder of this week and then moving forwards from next week.

For the remainder of this week, we are able to offer either the main hot meal option or a cheese packed lunch, which will need to be collected daily from the offices between 12.00pm and 12.30pm. With effect from Monday 11th January, we are able to offer either a bundle of lunch items to be collected from the offices once a week on a Monday between 12.00pm and 1.00pm, or an eGift code emailed directly to you which can then be redeemed via the Edenred website to obtain a supermarket voucher. To submit your preference, you must complete the survey using the following link **[no later than 12.00pm tomorrow, Wednesday 6th January.](#)**

If you have children in both schools, you will be able to collect all your meals from the infant school to save you the need of visiting both offices.

Regarding the Edenred vouchers, we are no longer offering the option of receiving your vouchers printed by the school. Over the Christmas break, this method encountered a problem which has caused a delay in them being processed and we do not want families kept waiting for these. Providing you have an email address, you can redeem the eGift code on the Edenred website, and you will be emailed the voucher for your chosen supermarket. This can then be scanned from a smartphone if you do not have a printer.

We apologise for the tight response times for these surveys but it is necessary for ordering of food supplies and for the vouchers to be processed. Unfortunately, you cannot change your choice once submitted.
